

Public Safety Guidelines

SWE public safety guidelines and protocols to all event participants (including members, partners, speakers, SWE staff, and volunteers) prior to entering the Buffalo Niagara Convention Center and Hyatt Regency Buffalo Hotel.

General Standard COVID-19 Health Symptoms, but not limited:

Do you have any of these symptoms that you cannot attribute to another condition?

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- Recent onset of loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

If an individual has the following symptoms before or during the Conference do not attend the Conference or leave the Conference and seek medical attention.

MANDATORY HEALTH SCREENING FOR ALL

Be ready to present the following to Security as you enter the WE Local conference facility.

- Option A: Printed copy, photo of, or original CDC Vaccination Card.
- Option B: Printed copy of your Negative COVID-19 Test (No older than 72 hours before the conference)
- All must provide a valid Photo Identification Card. (Driver's License or State I.D.)

Public Safety Guidelines

FACE MASKS

All individuals entering the WE Local Conference in Buffalo Niagara Convention Center and Hyatt Regency Buffalo Hotel, which includes move-in, move-out and show days, will be required to wear a mask, except when eating or drinking.

- All individuals include:
- SWE HQ Staff.
- Volunteers.
- Attendees.
- Partners / Exhibitors.
- SWE Vendors.

MANDATORY PUBLIC SAFETY DAILY WRISTBANDS

SWE will provide a daily wristband to all attendees, partners /exhibitors, speakers, SWE HQ staff, volunteers, and vendors to wear during the conference once they clear the public safety guidelines.

PUBLIC SAFETY CHECK IN ENTRANCE

SWE will designate a check point entrance for the conference near registration.

PUBLIC SAFETY SIGNAGE

PPE Signage will be placed around the facility with all the public safety guidelines.
