

Public Safety Guidelines

SWE public safety guidelines and protocols apply to all event participants, members, partners, speakers, SWE staff, and volunteers prior to entering the WE Local London conference at the Sheraton Grand London Park Lane.

General Standard COVID-19 Health Symptoms, but not limited:

Do you have any of these symptoms that you cannot attribute to another condition?

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- Recent onset of loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

If an individual has the following symptoms before or during the Conference do not attend the Conference or leave the Conference and seek medical attention.

MANDATORY HEALTH SCREENING FOR ALL

Be ready to present a valid photo identification card to security as you enter the Sheraton Grand London Park Lane as well as:

- Printed copy or photograph of vaccination certificate
- OR
- Printed copy of a negative COVID-19 test (within 72 hours of conference start time)

All WE Local London participants must comply with the health screening to enter the conference.

Public Safety Guidelines

FACE MASKS

All individuals entering the WE Local London conference at the Sheraton Grand London Park Lane, which includes move-in, move-out and show days, will be required to wear a mask, except when eating or drinking.

- All individuals include:
- SWE HQ Staff.
- Volunteers.
- Attendees.
- Partners / Exhibitors.
- SWE Vendors.

MANDATORY PUBLIC SAFETY WRISTBANDS

SWE will provide a wristband to all attendees, partners /exhibitors, speakers, SWE HQ staff, volunteers, and vendors to wear during the conference once their vaccination status or negative COVID-19 test has been reviewed.

PUBLIC SAFETY CHECK IN ENTRANCE

SWE will designate a check point entrance for the conference near registration.
